



WE TEST IT AUTO METER FULL-SWEEP ELECTRIC FUEL GAUGE

Of course the fuel gauge didn't work in the CC/Rambler project when we bought it. They never do. The solution was a Cobalt programmable full-sweep electric gauge that can be used with the stock sender. At 2 1/8 inches, it also fit in the stock dash using the original bezels. After hooking up the wiring, we filled the gas tank and wired in an instant-on button (or you can just cross the trigger wires). When activated, the gauge needle sweeps slowly, allowing us to program the gauge to indicate a full tank. That's all there is to it. When we started the car, the gauge read full and proceeded to track the fuel level as accurately as any stock unit we've used.

MORE HEMI HOP-UPS

What It Is: JBA headers and after-cat exhaust for '05 and '06 Chargers and Magnums.

Why You Care: The aftermarket is rallying behind Chrysler's V-8 rear-drive sedans with a rapidly growing list of products, and here are two more. JBA's headers feature 1.75-inch tubing leading to 3-inch collectors, and they're available uncoated or with a silver or titanium high-temp coating. The after-cat system is composed of 2.5-inch stainless tubes and an H-pipe crossover finished with 3-inch chrome-plated tips.

We Say: The headers look like art, and the exhaust sounds like the bomb.

How Much: List price for the headers is \$600. The exhaust system is another \$550. Both items are direct bolt-ins for the factory manifolds and pipes and are available through JBA authorized dealers.
